Carlos Hank and is a Police Captain with the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department. He began his career with the Las Vegas Police Metropolitan Police Department as a Corrections Officer in 2000. Carlos graduated from Columbia Southern University with a Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice.

In February of 2020, Carlos was promoted to Captain and entrusted with commanding all aspects of Bolden Area Command. Bolden Area Command encompasses approximately 17 square miles in and around the historic West Side of Las Vegas. The area command places a considerable interest in strengthening its relationship with the community and conducts over 100 community events each year.

As a lieutenant, Carlos served in numerous assignments that prepared him for his role as Captain. He had the opportunity to serve in the Support Operations Bureau as Watch Commander and the Community Policing Division as a Shift Lieutenant overseeing Patrol Operations and Field Training. Lastly, Carlos served in the Internal Affairs Bureau overseeing administrative investigations of LVMPD employees.

Before becoming a Lieutenant, Carlos worked as a Detective Sergeant, tasked with overseeing a team of detectives that investigated everything from property crimes to violent crimes. Working in this capacity allowed him the opportunity to help further the Sheriff's initiative to reduce violent crime and improve quality of life.

Carlos has been decorated numerous times for outstanding performance in the line of duty. The most prestigious coming in 2006 when he received the Medal of Honor for his actions in response to a triple Homicide.

Carlos was a member of the LVMPD Body Camera committee that facilitated the selection, purchasing, training, and deployment of over 400 body cameras to equip our officers better and enhance the Trust through Transparency process with our community.

Carlos was one of the first lieutenants to respond to the October 1st Massacre. He commanded the Staging area, where he oversaw the deployment of over 50 Strike Teams into the theater of operations.

He enjoys playing golf, fishing and has been known to grill up some incredible barbeque in his free time. Carlos also enjoys shooting and has been a firearms instructor for over 20 years. He has been married to his wife Pam for 30 years, has three daughters and two grandchildren.
